Valid from 2nd semester 2023/24 (subject to alteration of prices)

Music school lessons for children and young adults are subsidised by the municipalities and the canton, therefore school fees are only 50% of the full costs.

Discounts

For the second child of the same family 12%, for the third child 24% and for each additional child 36% will be deducted. In case of multiple enrolment (weekly lessons E35, G2 or G3), a 20% discount is granted for each additional subject (2nd instrument).

Exceptions: We do not grant any discount on adult lessons, on all subjects marked with * and scholarship holders.

Payment by instalments

Payment by instalments is possible upon request. The payment will be divided into three instalments at a surcharge of Fr. 30.-- per semester.

Scholarships

Music school lessons should be available to all children and young adults regardless of their financial circumstances. The conditions are available on our website. Scholarship applications for the upcoming semester must be submitted by June 1 or December 1.
